Einstein charity renews on West 38th

A non-profit founded in 1931 at the behest of Albert Einstein has renewed its lease at Handler's 263 West 38th Street. The International Rescue Committee signed a long-term renewal for the 10,000 s/f sixth floor of the property. The asking rent is in the high \$40s psf.

Laurence Briody, Manny Fitzgerald, Joan Meixner, Peter Gamber of CBRE represented the tenant in the lease renewal.

Handler Real Estate Organization was represented in house by Scott Galin, Richard Farley and Darell Handler.

The International Rescue Committee (IRC) is an humanitarian aid group which responds to the world's worst humanitarian crises and helps people whose lives and livelihoods are shattered by conflict and disaster to survive, recover, and gain control of their future.

IRC was founded in 1933 at the request of Albert Einstein.
